## **5. Be Brave in Your Mission**

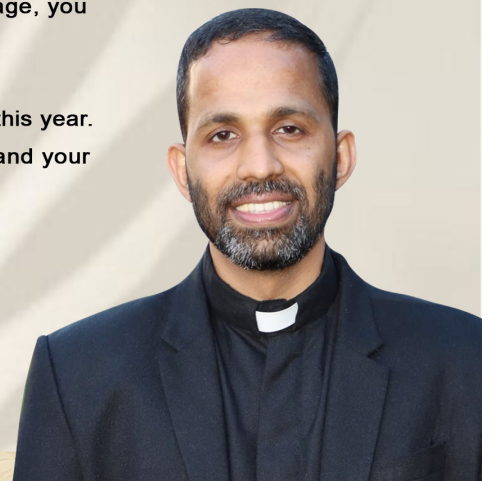

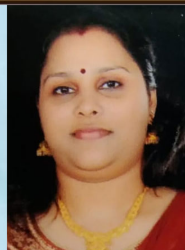
